
3rd Saturday Paint Out William B. Pond Recreation Area-American River Feb. 21, 2015 9:30am – 12:30PM

Rebecca Jaggers will host the 3rd Saturday Paint Out in David's absence.

William B. Pond recreation area is one of the most well established and popular parks along the river. Physically handicapped anglers can access the large, man-made fishing pond via a specialized fishing pier and ramp. Paved walking trails gently slope around the park. There are restrooms, tables and a short walk to the river. Fees: \$5.00 per vehicle.

How to get there: From U.S. Highway 50, take the Watt Avenue northbound off-ramp. Turn right at Fair Oaks Blvd. Then make another right on Arden Way. Arden Way will come to an end at the park's entrance. After passing through the entrance and paying the fee drive and enter the large parking lot to the left, 1st or 2nd driveway and park near the restrooms. If you are at the Gazebo at the end of the park you went to far. The plan is to meet here by the

bike trail and hike down to the river near the rapids. You will cross the bike trail and follow the paved trail until it joins the access road, then take the first trail to the left. That will take you to a wide bank by the rapids. It is a beautiful area. Watch birds, otters etc. It is a 12 minute walk. Rebecca will guide you. The trail is paved most of the way.
